



# Province of Fryslân

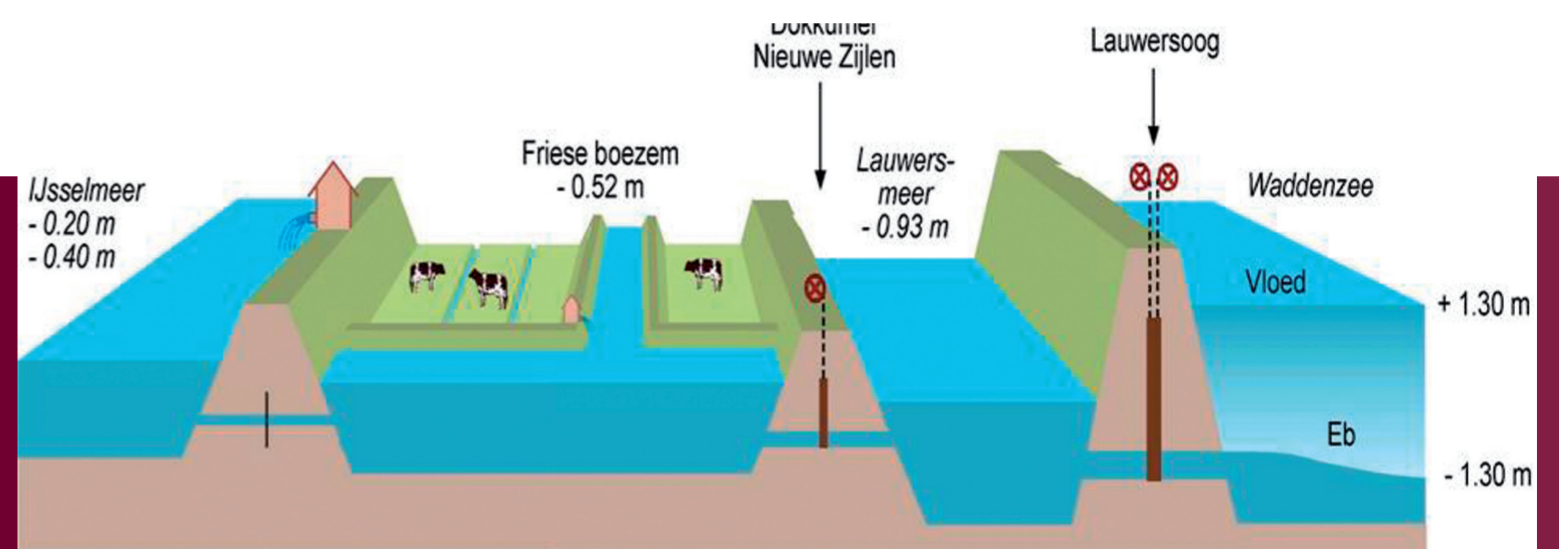
## Introduction

The Province of Fryslân is located in the North of the Netherlands. Fryslân is one of the twelve provinces of the Netherlands. Fryslân has a population of around 640.000 distributed over 31 municipalities.

Fryslân is the most watery Province of the Netherlands so water-management in Fryslân is very important. The Province is responsible for water policy and the "Wetterskip Fryslân" is carrying out this policy.

## Present situation and problems

Water is a dominant factor in the Frisian landscape. It has always been of great importance for the Frisian economy. Water management is an important issue for the Frisian politicians, but till now, the projects are concentrating on specific issues of water management. Now it is time to focus not only on details, but on the water cycle as a whole. This project makes a more integrated approach to the urban water cycle possible by combining existing knowledge and new experiences.



## Objectives of the pilotproject(s)
